

To develop a new operational model of care that will enable patient and family centered, community delivered, technology enabled integrated care across the continuum.







#### **Briefing Note to ELT**

- On April 7, Calgary's Complex Care Hub and EZVH partnered in the submission of a BN to ELT, which recommended:
  - The procurement of a standalone remote patient monitoring solution, to:
    - Increase the program capacity of both the CCH and EZVH to 50 virtual inpatients & 80 virtual ambulatory outpatients (both Covid + and -
    - Fully exploit the virtual care functions available in Connect Care
    - Be available for deployment in the near term
  - Transition the current Home Based Acute Care Working Group into the Provincial Virtual Hospital Coordination Office.





### Surge Planning

- The EZVH is positioned to support an Edmonton Zone wide approach to the Covid Pandemic plan, through:
  - Increased capacity for virtual 'inpatients': up to 50 concurrently
  - Increased capacity for virtual 'outpatients': up to 100 concurrently
  - Referrals from:
    - Emergency Department and Acute Inpatient wards
    - Specialist Clinics
    - Primary Care/Community, including:
      - Family Physician/Nurse Practitioner led clinics
      - Expo Centre
      - Secondary Assessment Centres
      - Continuing Care & other congregate living settings
      - Others as requested



#### **APRIL** Priorities

- Plan for surge in both virtual inpatient and outpatients
- Work with CPSM to acquire Remote Patient Monitoring (RPM) and develop workflows for virtual inpatient and outpatient streams of the EZVH
- Complete PIA to launch RPM solution
- Acquire redeployed staff, ensure MIH has capacity
- Adapt workflows with referring groups as required to maximize impact across EZ
- Continue to socialize EZVH enhanced capacity throughout EZ channels



#### **MAY Priorities**

- is the successful vendor for remote monitoring
- Implement Remote Patient Monitoring in inpatient and outpatient streams of the EZVH
- Be responsive to the needs of individuals living in the EZ, both with and without Covid infection
- Adapt workflows as required to maximize impact across EZ
- Implement enhanced staffing strategy in partnership with Home Care and MIH
- Continue to socialize EZVH enhanced capacity throughout EZ channels (Secondary assessment Centres, Primary Care, Integrated Operations Centre)
