

AMA Medals for Distinguished Service 2016

- **Dr. John M. Conly**, nationally respected and internationally renowned as one of Canada's leading infectious disease specialists. His impact on improving standards of medical practice spans both research and clinical areas, and his dedication to strengthening the medical profession has had measurable results. Dr. Conly has been the recipient of myriad awards and invited to join several prestigious groups, including the World Health Organization's Advisory Group on Integrated Surveillance of Antimicrobial Resistance
- **Dr. Christopher J. (Chip) Doig**, a tireless champion for the medical profession, who has undertaken pivotal leadership roles that have advanced the practice of medicine and improved the health care system for all Albertans. In addition to his myriad clinical, research and teaching responsibilities, Dr. Doig has served as president of the AMA, member of the CMA's Committee on Ethics, board member of the STARS Society and president of the Alberta Society of Intensive Care Physicians.

Member Emeritus Award

- **Dr. Gerhard N. Kiefer**, is a pediatric orthopedic surgeon at Alberta Children's Hospital in Calgary. He is also a clinical associate professor in the Department of Surgery at the University of Calgary. Dr. Kiefer has contributed his expertise to countless hospital, university, national and international associations and societies on various committees, board and working groups.
- **Dr. Christine P. Molnar**, is a clinical associate professor in the Department of Diagnostic Imaging at the University of Calgary. Her area of practice/specialty is nuclear medicine, PET/CT and diagnostic radiology. She has had long-time involvement with the Section of Diagnostic Imaging and the Alberta Society of Radiology and has served on many hospital, university, CPSA, provincial and ministerial task forces and committees.

Long Service

- **Dr. Arlie J. Fawcett**, is Section Chief, Inpatient Psychiatry, Consultation Liaison and Psychiatric Emergency Services, Calgary Zone, with Alberta Health Services. She has been an assistant professor in the Department of Psychiatry at the University of Calgary since 1988.

Award for Compassionate Service

- **Dr. Annalee Coakley**, for her work as the Medical Director of the Mosaic Refugee Health Clinic in Calgary. She has gone far beyond the duties this title entails and has demonstrated an incredible capacity for caring, commitment and drive to advocate for the refugee population not only in Calgary, but nationally and internationally. Dr. Coakley has worked tirelessly to ensure that the refugee patients at the clinic are provided with the highest standard of care, despite facing significant barriers.

Dr. William Marsden Award in Medical Ethics

- **Dr. Christopher J. (Chip) Doig**, he teaches medical ethics in many disciplines, including medicine, other health care professions, and law. As a consultant he has had a strong influence in the field of research ethics at Alberta's universities, the College of Physicians and Surgeons, and the Alberta Cancer Board. He also has been an expert advisor to the provincial and federal governments. A former president of the Alberta Medical Association, Dr. Doig has served on the CMA Board of Directors and Committee on Ethics.

Physician Misericordia Award

- **Dr. Jordan S. Cohen**, is a psychiatrist with expertise in physician health training at all levels of medical education. Because of him thousands of trainees and practising physicians are better equipped to manage their health and maintain their professionalism. In 2009 Dr. Cohen won a CMA leadership award as an early-career physician. This Physician Misericordia Award further acknowledges his exceptional commitment to the profession.
 - **Dr. Jane B. Lemaire**, throughout her career Dr. Jane Lemaire has passionately engaged doctors in the hope of a future where physician health and well-being is seen as a quality indicator for the health care system. As a clinical professor at the University of Calgary, she has a reputation as a superb clinician and role model for female internists. Also, she has been an important voice on the advisory committee of the Alberta Medical Association's Physician and Family Support Program, which she currently chairs.
